IN VIEW of the headquarters agreement between the Kingdom of Belgium and the Surveillance Authority of the European Free Trade Association signed on the 22nd of December 1994,

DESIRING to specify the regulations governing privileges and immunities necessary for the exercising of the functions of the Surveillance Authority of the European Free Trade Association

HAVE agreed on the following :

Article 1

Article 15 of the headquarters agreement of the 22nd of December 1994 is replaced by the following text :

The head of the office of the Surveillance Authority of the European Free Trade Association and his two deputies shall enjoy diplomatic privileges and immunities.

Article 2

Each Party will notify the other of the completion of the necessary internal procedures for the entry into force of this Protocol.

Article 3


This Protocol will enter into force the 30th day following the date on which the last Party to complete the procedure has declared to the other Party that the necessary internal procedures for the entry into force of the Protocol have been completed.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Plenipotentiaries have signed this Protocol.


DONE at Brussels, the 6th of July 2001, in two originals, in the English, French and Dutch languages, the three texts being equally authentic.
